Zenith Aviation, Inc announced today the purchase of all remaining Dornier 328 stock from San Antonio, Texas based M7 Aerospace. M7 previously purchased the Dornier 328 wing manufacturing and USA support parts depot from the bankrupt Fairchild Dornier Company. Fairchild was the manufacturer of the Dornier 328 Jet and Turbo Prop regional airliners.

The purchase includes some 8,700 line items representing over 4 million parts. It is forecasted that the ten-plus truckloads of material will take over six months to verify the condition and paperwork for each individual part before entry into Zenith's Inventory Control computer system.

Mr. Rober Stanford, Zenith's President, stated "our intention is to become the preferred supplier for the worldwide fleet of 328's and this massive purchase of Dornier spare parts verifies Zenith Aviation's commitment to the Do 328 program and operators."
